Adapted from Psalm 51:1-17

Have mercy on me, O God, according to your loving-kindness; in your great compassion blot out my offenses.

Accept our repentance, O God, for the wrongs we have done.

For our neglect of human need and suffering and our indifference to injustice and cruelty,

For all false judgments, for uncharitable thoughts toward our neighbors,

and for our prejudice and contempt toward those who differ from us,

For our waste and pollution of your creation

and our lack of concern for those who come after us,

Holy and merciful God, have mercy on us.

Restore us, O God, and let your anger depart from us.

Favorably hear us, O God, for your mercy is great. Amen.
