

Highlights of the January 25, 2025, Stated Session Meeting

A stated Session meeting was held on Saturday, January 25, 2025, at end of the Session's retreat at Rock Eagle 4-H Center.

Luanne Rigsby presented the Clerk's report which included the approval of the 2024 church statistical report updating the total membership to 213 and a letter from Jim Newland awarding a grant of \$10,598 from The Central/Covenant Endowment Fund to be used at Session's discretion.

The Financial Summary for December, 2024, indicated that everything looks to be on track financially with received pledges exceeding what was anticipated.

The Session will hold regular Stated Session meetings on the 4th Tuesday of the month at 6:15 p.m.

Session approved Caly DePalma and Brian Herndon as two of Covenant's 4 commissioners to the February 22th NEGA Presbytery meeting at Reid Memorial Presbyterian Church in Augusta, GA. Session elected Luanne Rigsby as stated Clerk of the Session for 2025.

Session approved a motion to continue serving Communion the first Sunday of every month, Maundy Thursday and Christmas Eve.
