Highlights of the June 23, 2024 Stated Session Meeting

A stated Session meeting was held on June 23, 2024. For her devotional, Kathryn Fowler read 2 Corinthians 5:17-18 and Isaiah 43:19 on grace and new beginnings. God invites us to release yesterday's burdens and embrace the promise of tomorrow. Because of grace, it is never too late for new life!

According to the Financial Summary for May, 2024, we will probably end the year with a surplus. Ministry Teams were urged to submit reimbursements before June 30th, the end of the fiscal year.

Clerk, Luanne Rigsby stated that following some corrections made in the numbers and the passing of Jim Verbrugge, the total membership is 212.

Stephanie Cahill, inactive elder, has been nominated with Dick Zimdars to serve on the Nominating Committee for the next class of elders. They will solicit the congregation for nominations of someone, who has never been an elder to be elected with them by the congregation at an upcoming Congregational Meeting.

Kathryn Fowler, member of the PNC, introduced Rev. Joel Thomas (Tom) Buchanan, Jr. as the newly called pastor of Covenant Presbyterian Church. Tom told a bit about himself and his wife, Lisa, and expressed his gratitude and excitement for this call. He answered questions from Session and said that he hopes to learn as much as he can about Covenant to get up to speed as much as possible before he begins work. Session approved that July 31, 2024, will be Rev. Teresa Franklin's last day as interim pastor and August 1, 2024, will be Rev. Tom Buchanan's start date.

Session approved that on September 14, 2024, Covenant will host the NEGA Presbytery's Presbyterian Women's Workshop, originally planned for June.

Session discussed the possibility of offering programming for our youth in the coming months with the resignation of the youth minister at First Presbyterian. Conversation to be continued.

Bert Ballard-Myer of the Mission Outreach Ministry Team announced two new outreach offerings that Amy Baer is working on for this fall: Experiencing Creation Through the Arts and Theology on Tap Bible Study for ages 21 and older.


